## A HALF DAYS VISIT OF THE CAPITAL HANOI



Hanoi, capital of Vietnam since the 11th century, dazzles visitors with its unique blend of oriental lifestyle, French colonial architecture, tree-lined boulevards, peaceful lakes and friendly locals.

- 0800 Departure. Start the tour at HoChiMinh's Mausoleum. Far from the madding crowd, enjoy the architectural and historical aspects of ' Uncle Ho's' final resting place.
- Just next door is Ho Chi Minh's 'house on stilts', his temporary residence between 1954 till 1969, the wooden ethnic minority style house is surrounded by quiet and peaceful gardens.
- The One Pillar Pagoda, founded by King Ly Thai To in 1049. The design resembles a lotus flower and offers serene surroundings in Hanoi's bustling streets.
- After take a short drive to The Temple of Literature, which was Vietnam's first university founded in 1070, this charming building is one of the most renowned in Hanoi.
- The Army, History or National Fine Arts Museum will be visited next, only one can be visited so decide which one you would most like to see.\*
- Take a Cyclo ride through the streets of the Old Quarter\*\*. Relax as you weave through the narrow alleys of Hanoi's ancient 36 street system. Every street sells a specialised type of good, see among others Herbal Medicine street, Decorative Paper Street, Matt Street and Cathedral Street (St Joseph's). On Ma May Street, stop at a traditionally restored communal house and see how the Old Quarters residents once lived.
- Arrive back at your hotel at 12.30.
